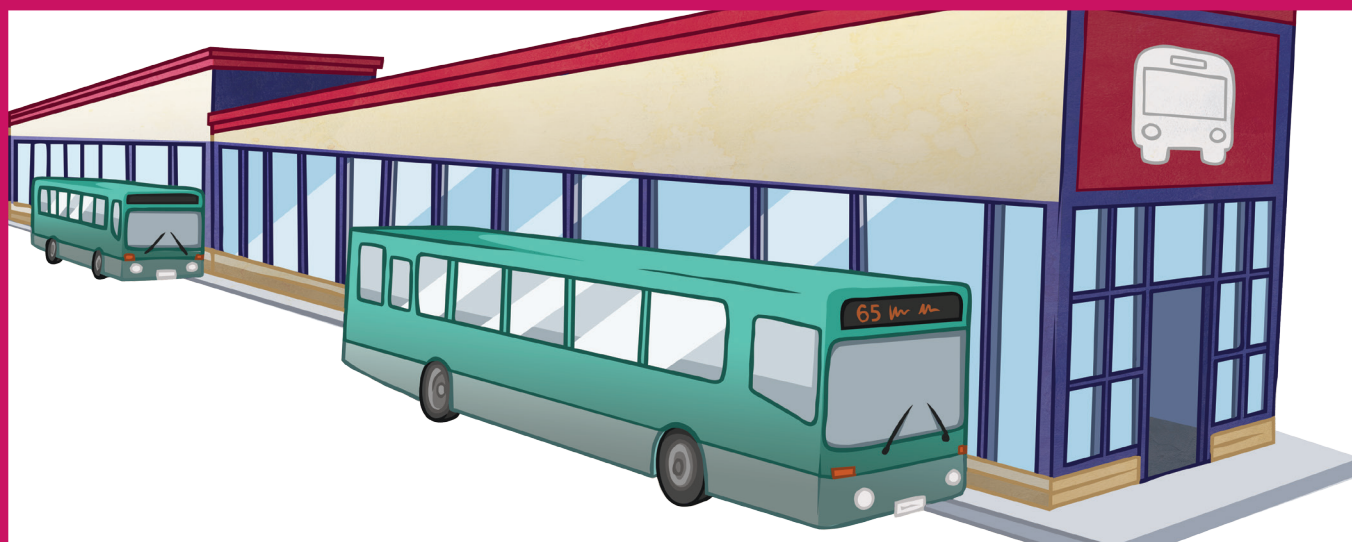


Before getting the bus...

It's OK, you take the seat. I'll be getting off soon.

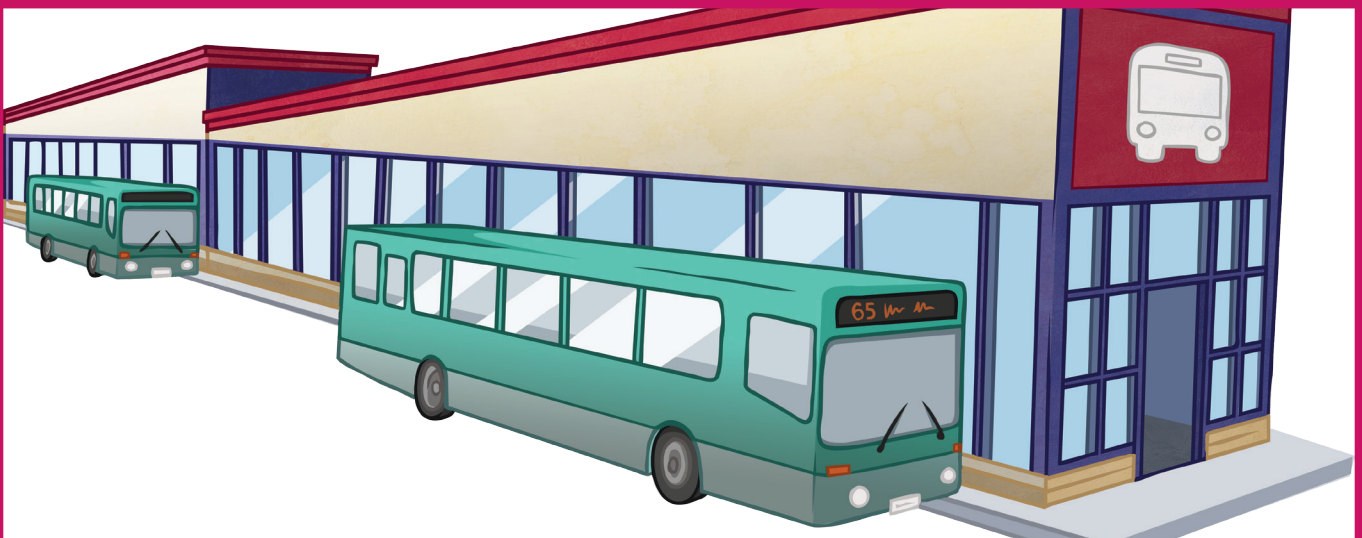
I'm getting off at this stop.
